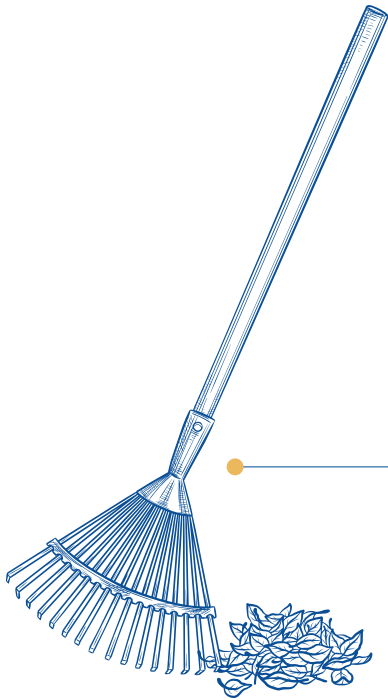

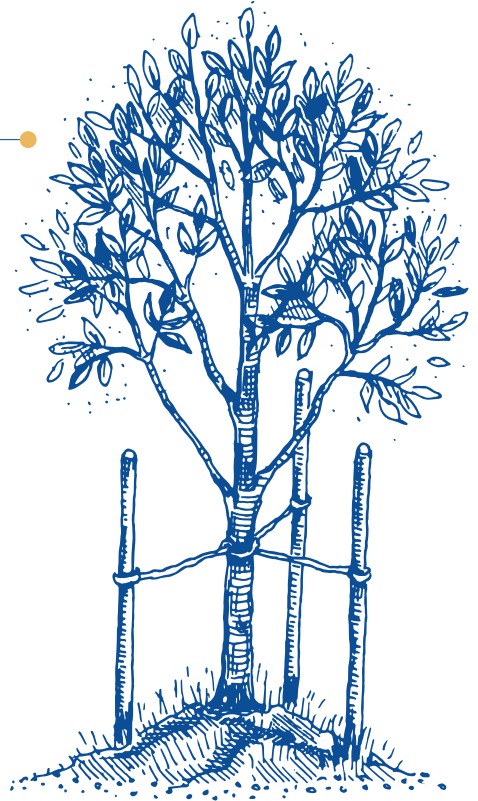


CLEAN UP

Thinking of adding new trees? Fall is the perfect time for trees and shrubs to establish roots.



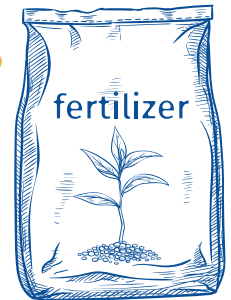
MULCH

Giving your garden a new layer of mulch helps protect plants from colder temperatures.



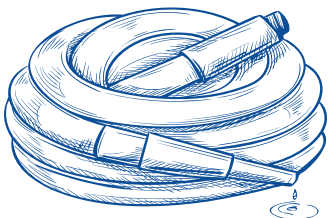
FERTILIZE

DRAIN ALL WATER

Empty your hoses, fountains and drop-irrigation tubing.



CUT BACK PERENNIALS

Remove dead leaves and cut stems; if your perennials have really grown this year, consider dividing them.
