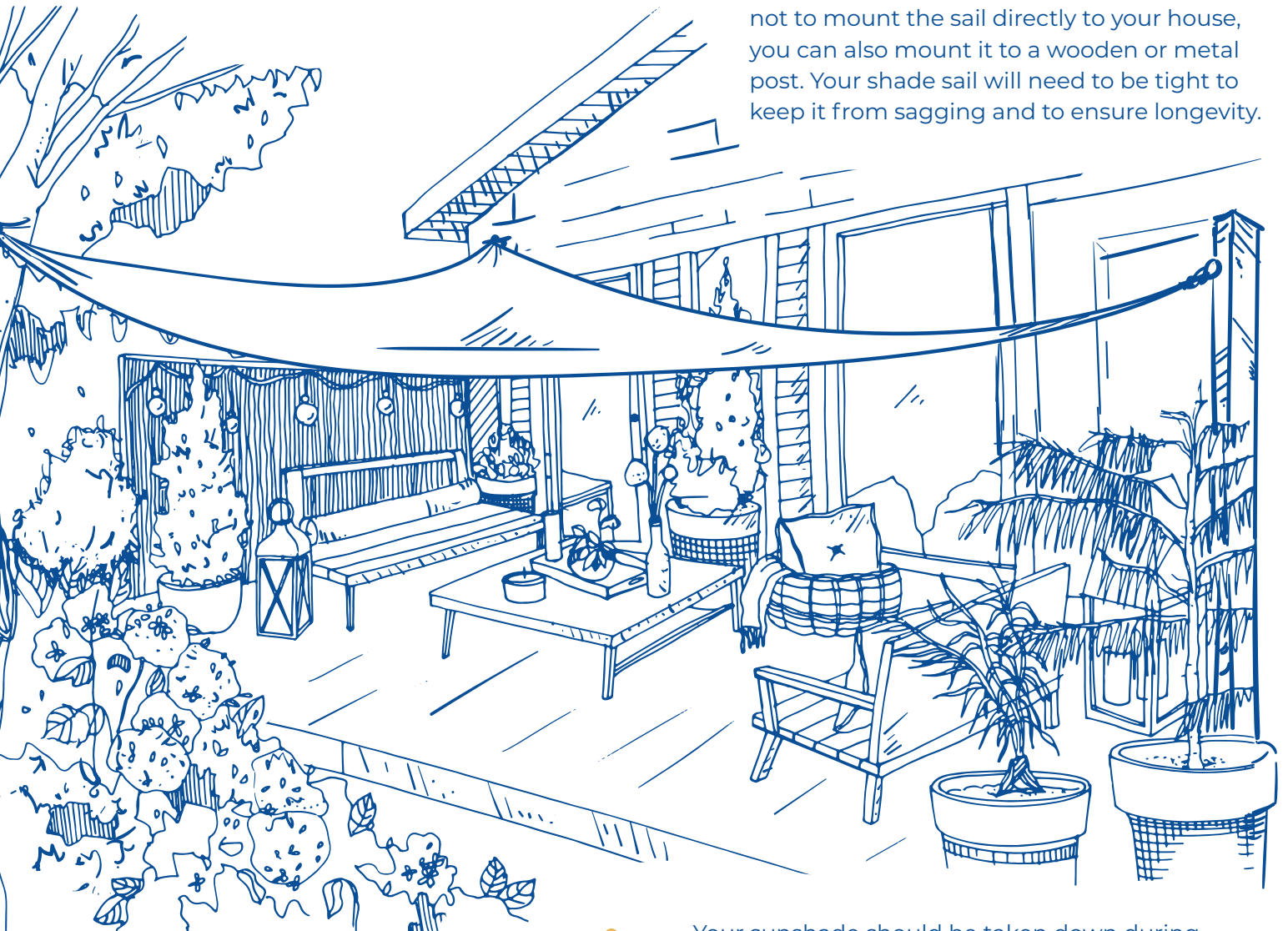


INSTALLING A SHADE SAIL

If you're looking to add more shade or protection to your outdoor space, a shade sail might be the answer. Shade sails are a cost effective and efficient way to increase usability of your space on long summer days while still leaving your house windows with access to natural light.

● The first step to installing a shade is choosing the correct size, shape and color. First, you'll need to choose the shape and, based on that, you can start to decide which dimensions work best for the area where it will be installed.

● Once measured you can begin the mounting process. To mount the sail to the exterior of your home, you'll need to choose a strong location such as concrete or brick. This point will need to withstand the force of the weather elements that your house faces. If you prefer not to mount the sail directly to your house, you can also mount it to a wooden or metal post. Your shade sail will need to be tight to keep it from sagging and to ensure longevity.



● Your sunshade should be taken down during extreme weather or a heavy rainstorm.
