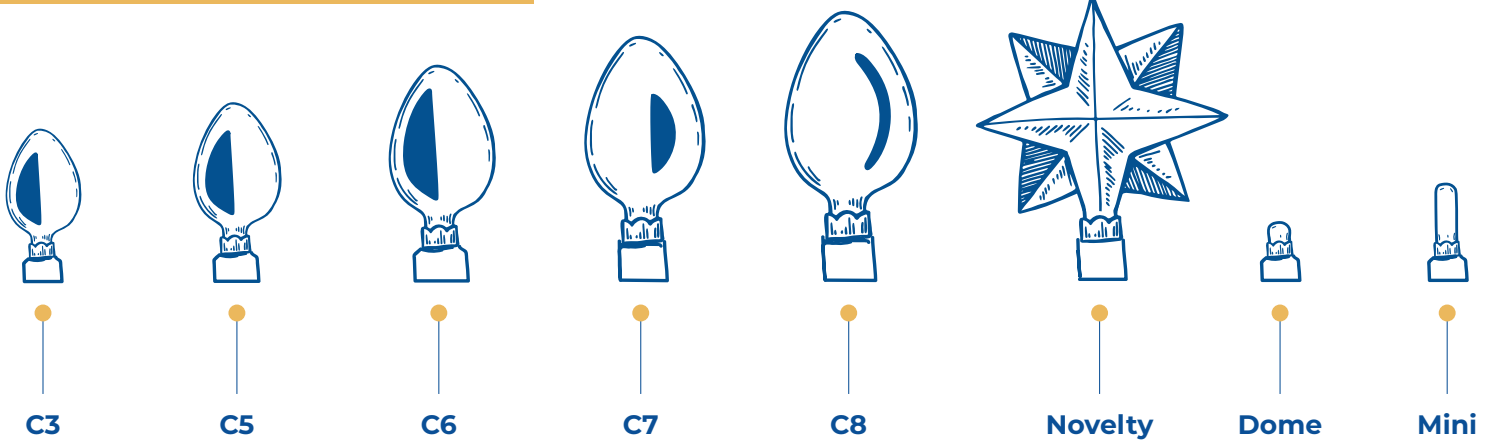


KNOW YOUR LIGHTS

LED holiday lights last longer than traditional lights and are more energy efficient. They stay cool to the touch and are very bright.

Incandescent lights are usually budget-friendly. They are very bright, show only one color per bulb and can heat up with extended use.

TYPES OF LIGHTS



PICK A STYLE

SINGLE ROW

Even one row of lights along your roof will make your house look festive. Consider adding wreaths or lights in second story windows to balance the look.

FOCAL POINTS

Choose one point on your house, like the front door, to highlight with different colored lights or by adding heavy lights.

SIMPLE OUTLINE

Simply outlining different features of your home (front door, windows, garage door) will give you a traditional look.

COLOR

Add pops of color if you want to create a unique holiday look!
