


# SAFETY TIPS

## THINGS TO CONSIDER

- 
- Never overload electrical outlets or extension cords. Make sure to check the manufacturer's instructions and don't exceed the number of recommended connections.
  - Only use lights that were made for exterior displays.
  - Test your lights before you install them to make sure they work. Check for cords that are worn or showing wires and immediately dispose of them.
  - Use automatic timers to shut the lights off during specific times.
  - Don't run electrical cords along high traffic areas.
  - Avoid old nails, staples, screws or broken hooks when mounting your display.
  - Work your way up when you're working with trees. Start at the trunk and wrap the lights around in a spiral.
  - Use replacement bulbs of the correct voltage and type.
